## Deployment Health Assessment Program (DHAP) https://www.usar.army.mil/DHAP

DHAP provides early identification of emerging deployment related health conditions and serves as a gateway to care and treatment. There are three deployment health assessments (DHAs) taken during a deployment cycle: 1) the Pre-Deployment Health Assessment (Pro-DHA) taken 30 days before or after redeployment; 2) the Post-Deployment Health Assessment (PDHA) taken 30 days before or after redeployment; 3) and the Post-Deployment Health Reassessment (PDHRA) taken 90 - 180 days after redeployment.

#### **Commander Portal Access Manager (CPAM)**

The CPAM will validate user requests and grant access once they have met their training requirements for CDR Portal Access. CPAMs will perform quality assurance checks to ensure that the right users have access to the system and that individuals that no longer need access are deactivated. To request the CPAM role, provide Duty Appointment / Additional Duty Memo signed by your CoS or designee with the following information for each individual requesting the role: Full Name, DODID, Enterprise Email, Highest UIC needed.
