



The emblem was approved for use as a plaque in 1972 and is used as an unofficial identification device of the United States Army Reserve. The Army originally authorized this minuteman symbol in 1960 to represent the Chief, Army Reserve (CAR) on the CAR's positional flag. The 1983 version of the CAR positional flag is posted below.

Symbolism: The minuteman has traditionally been used to represent the citizen Soldier:

The **Wreath** signifies achievement and accomplishment

Gold is symbolic of honor and excellence

Dark Blue signifies loyalty
