

Colonel Aaron J. Justice assumed command of the 510th Regional Support Group (RSG) on 19 May 2019. The 510th RSG's mission is to deploy a scalable headquarters to provide Mission Command and administrative support structure for managing and operating a base camp or base camp cluster in support of the Combatant Commander's operations in theater.

COL Justice graduated from the United States Military Academy in 1995, with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Environmental Engineering. After completion of the Engineer Officer Basic Course in 1995, he was assigned to the 16th / 54th Engineer Battalion in Bamberg, Germany, where he served as a platoon leader.

While in Bamberg he deployed with his unit to Bosnia-Herzegovina from December 1995 to November 1996. Upon returning, COL Justice was assigned as Company Executive Officer and Battalion Support Platoon Leader. Subsequently, he served 18 months as the Operations Officer for the Directorate of Public Works, 279th Base Support Battalion in Bamberg, Germany.

In June 2000, COL Justice left active duty and began his Reserve career with assignment to the 345th Support Center, Rear Area Operations Center as an Assistant Operations Officer. In July 2001, he assumed command of the 1172nd Transportation Detachment (MCT). From February 2003 to May 2004, the 1172nd MCT was mobilized in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. After deploying the 1st Armored Division from multiple installations throughout Germany, the 1172nd MCT deployed to Camp Virginia, Kuwait where it conducted movement control operations as the V Corps (Rear) MCT. After relinquishing command in February 2005, COL Justice became the Training Management Officer for the 3747th Multifunctional Training Brigade and later the Brigade S-3. He then served as the Commander of the 406th Human Resources Company in Kaiserslautern, Germany until January 2011. Upon promotion to Lieutenant Colonel, he served as the Executive Officer of 209th Digital Liaison Detachment in Wiesbaden, Germany. COL Justice served as the first Battalion Commander of the 446th Movement Control Battalion. He also served as the Deputy Chief of Operations, G3/5/7 of the 7th Mission Support Command in Kaiserslautern, Germany. From December of 2016 to May of 2019 he served as the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4 of the 7th Mission Support Command.

COL Justice is a graduate of Senior Service College, Joint and Combined Warfighting School-Hybrid, the Intermediate Level Education Course, and the Engineer Officer Basic and Advance Courses. Among his awards and decorations are the Meritorious Service Medal with a silver- and bronze oak-leaf clusters, Army Commendation Medal with oak-leaf cluster, Army Achievement Medal, Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal with six oak-leaf clusters, the Armed Forces Reserve Medal with hour glass and "M" device, the Meritorious Unit Citation, and the Army Superior Unit Award.

In March 2016, Colonel Justice received a Masters of Science in Project Management from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. In his civilian capacity, COL Justice is currently employed by SKE Technical Services GmbH as a Client/Operations Coordinator.
