- **Career Development Briefs** - To the population and/or your unit(s) regarding career progression, board statistics, broadening opportunities and more.
- **Unit Points of Contact** - CMOs can provide potential contacts at units of interest for transfers.
- **Position Advisement/Announcements** - Advise on potential career path choices or announce vacancies.
- **Branch Reclassifications** - Update AOC/Branch information following completion of unit PAG Action.
- **OER Profile Strength Review** - Assess strength of evaluations and provide general feedback.
- **Records Review/Updates** - Updates to records for Service Members without immediate HR support.
- **Board File Review** - Review files of Service Members going before a promotion board for accuracy.

## CAREER MANAGEMENT



### PLAN & KNOW YOUR CAREER PATHS

- Career Management starts with the [DA Pam 600-3 Smartbook](#). Officers are expected to service 18-24 months of Key Developmental (KD) assignments beginning at Captain. Most "Talent Development Models" are located at the end of the DA PAM 600-3.
- As a supplement, [DA Pam 611-21](#) provides information for Branches, Functional Areas, & Skill Identifiers.

### HOW ARE ACTIONS COMPLETED?

- The [USAR Personnel Actions Guide \(PAG\)](#) provides regulations, policies, checklists, & forms for categories such as Conditional Release, MRD Extension, Promotion, Reassignment, Resignation, Reclassification, & Retirement. [Select "Officer/Warrant Officer" \(Appendix A\)](#). (Most actions are completed at the unit level by your S-1 or HR representative).

### INTERESTED IN ACTIVE DUTY?

- For active duty opportunities, check eligibility & apply for [Active Guard Reserve \(AGR\)](#) or [Call to Active Duty \(CAD\)](#). For Active Duty Tours, visit [Tour of Duty \(TOD\)](#).

## BOARDS & PROMOTIONS



- Boards, whether for promotion or education, are released via MILPER while Promotions are governed by AR 600-8-29 & supplemented for RC by AR 135-155. Time in Grade (TIG) IAW Table 2-1:

To Rank	Education	TIG
1LT	BOLC	18 Months
CPT	Bachelors/BOLC	2 Years*
MAJ	CCC	4 Years*
LTC	ILE-CC	4 Years*
COL	AOC/FA	3 Years*

\*Refer to MILPER Zones of Consideration

- To ensure promotion to 1LT happens on time at 18 months TIG, 2LTs need to ensure the following are in iPERMS:
  - Appointment Letter
  - DA Form 71 (Oath)
  - DA Form 1059 (BOLC)
- Promotion to CPT, MAJ, LTC, & COL should refer to the [Board Schedule](#) and MILPER as published by DA Secretariat.
- For [Position Vacancy Boards \(PVBs\)](#), HRC publishes a Letter of Instruction which can be found on MilSuite.

### WHAT A CMO CAN NOT DO?

- Promotion Guarantees - CMOs can not rate, rank or estimate probability for promotion selection.
- Reasons for Non-Selection (Promotion/Boards) - CMOs are not sworn members of the board, we do not receive insight into the reason for non-selection.
- Flag Removal or Involvement process.
- PME Enrollment - This is initiated by the unit.
- Generation of Promotion Orders - Unit [PAG Action](#).
- Mandatory Removal Date (MRD) & Retirement Points Corrections/Updates - [PAG \(MRD\)](#) or [HRC](#).

- BOLC is managed by the USAR Initial Military Training (IMT) Team & class requests must be completed via [PAG action](#) with your unit HR/S-1.
- CCC, ILE-CC, & AOC are all ATRRS applications submitted through unit & command channels to HRC for approval.

### ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

- Additional training opportunities include [APDE](#) & [BOP](#) via HRC.
- Check [USARC G1 Incentives Branch](#) to see if you qualify for any Selected Reserve Incentives Program bonus.
- For additional information, questions, or requests, please contact your Branch CMO.
