United States Army Reserve Command (USARC) Aviation Directorate requires the following documents for consideration into USAR Aviation:

- Select Individual Flight Test (SIFT) Score**
- DD Form 2808 (Qualified Flight Physical)**
- Letter of Acceptance (LOA)**
- DA Form 705 (APFT Score Card)**
- DD Form 5500 (HT/WT Worksheet)**
- Unofficial College Transcripts**
- CDT Photo/DA Photo**
- Military Biographical Summary**
- Letter(s) of Recommendation (LOR) Top**
- Three Duty Location Choices¹**
- Civilian Job Resume**



* Note: Only Class 1A Flight Physicals stamped "Approved" by Fort Rucker are acceptable for commission into the Aviation Branch. A minimum passing SIFT score of 40 is also required, and is a prerequisite to scheduling a Class 1A Flight Physical. An AFPT score of 270 is highly recommended. All interested candidates should interview with a potential USAR Aviation unit of assignment and coordinate a Letter of Acceptance (LOA) to be included in their selection packet. All leadership, aviation, and military skills/experience is highly encouraged in order to best assess the candidate's potential for the Aviation Branch.

¹ 2LTs will not be accessed into fixed wing positions for their initial tour of duty.
