\$5K available to all MOSs, can be combined with cash bonus; UIC coded in REQUEST.

**WILL TRAIN OPTIONS** 

Soldiers have the option to transfer to a critical MOS for additional incentives once trained. Review the In-Out Call list for eligibility. "Conversion Bonus" offers an option for those outside their ETS window. You must be E-6 and below with less than 12 years of service.

# POST 9/11 GI BILL TRANSFER OF EDUCATION BENEFITS (TEB) PROGRAM

Allows Soldiers to transfer the unused portion of their Post 9/11 GI Bill to their eligible dependent(s) in exchange for a one–time, four–year Additional Duty Service Obligation (ADSO) to the Army.
