SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority #21-07: Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act Initial Denial Authority

In accordance with the above listed references, I delegate authority to the USARC Chief of the Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act Office to release or deny the release of all records for which the Chief of Army Reserve is the initial denial authority. Coordination with the USARC Staff Judge Advocate, Administrative Law Branch, is required for a legal review prior to providing responses to complex records requests.

3. I retain authority to cancel or withdraw this permission at any time. Upon assignment of a new Chief of Army Reserve, all delegations are subject to review, cancellation, or change.
