2. I hereby delegate authority to the U.S. Army Human Resources Command (HRC) Reserve Personnel Management Directorate (RPMD) Chief, Enlisted Management Division (EMD) to involuntarily assign USAR AGR Soldiers as detailed Recruiters.

3. In accordance with reference c, and within current AGR end strength limitations, HRC will fill AGR positions in the Required Recruiter Force (RRF) to 100%. Detailed Recruiters will normally serve 36 months upon assignment at U.S. Army Recruiting Command.

4. This delegation remains in effect until superseded, rescinded or withdrawn.
