MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority #25-22: Intergovernmental Support Agreements

1. References.

a. Memorandum, Secretary of the Army, SAIE-ZA, subject: Delegation of Authority to Approve Intergovernmental Support Agreements Entered into Pursuant to Title 10 United States Code § 2679, 21 July 2023.

b. Memorandum, Assistant Secretary of the Army (Installations, Energy, and Environment), SAIE-ZA, subject: Delegation of Authority to Approve Intergovernmental Support Agreements Entered into Pursuant to Title 10 United States Code § 2679, 27 July 2023.

2. I delegate authority to the Readiness Division (RD) and the 9th Mission Support Command (MSC) Commanding Generals to approve Intergovernmental Support Agreements (IGSA) between the U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) and state and local governments to provide, receive, or share installation support services with annual individual values of \$5 million or less. An IGSA must serve the best interests of the Army by enhancing mission effectiveness, creating efficiencies, or economies of scale, including reduced costs that benefit the Army.

3. Consistent with the provisions of Title 10 United States Code § 2679(a)(2), an IGSA may be entered on a sole-source basis and for a term not to exceed 10 years.

4. RD and the 9th MSC Commanding Generals will brief me prior to making decisions in cases where the proposed decision represents a change in precedent or policy; is of significant White House, Congressional, Army, USAR or public interest; or has been, or should be, of interest or concern to me.

5. Further delegation is not authorized. This authority will extend to USAR-funded Installations where the RD Commanding General is designated as the Senior Commander by the Army's Installation Management Command (e.g., 63rd RD with Fort Hunter Liggett, CA).

6. Unless expressly prohibited by law, directive, regulation, or policy, I may subdelegate my authority in writing to authorize executing a task order for an IGSA to a General Officer or member of the Senior Executive Service. Notwithstanding any further delegation, I will hold you responsible for all actions taken pursuant to this delegation.

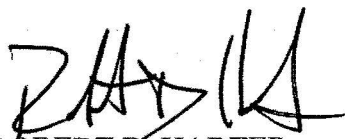
7. This delegation is effective immediately and will expire two (2) years from the date of this

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memorandum, unless earlier suspended, revoked, or superseded. All prior delegations of this authority are rescinded.
