SUBJECT: Exception to Army Regulation 140-10, Assignments, Attachments, Details, and Transfers

1. References:

- a. AR 140-10 (Assignments, Attachments, Details, and Transfers)
- b. AR 614-100 (Officer Assignment Policies and Procedures)
- 2. As an exception to AR 140-10, paragraphs 2-31 and 2-32, all Army Medical Department (AMEDD) Officers are authorized for voluntary assignment to non-command branch immaterial (01A) positions.
- 3. Prior to reassignment into an 01A position, AMEDD officers must have completed a minimum of three years in their initial AMEDD assignment. AMEDD officers, not including 67 and 70 series, are not authorized to serve in lower graded 01A positions.
- 4. Promotion while serving in a 01A position will require promotion board selection and assignment in a billet of the next higher grade.
- 5. This exception to policy is effective immediately and expires 12 months from the date of this memorandum unless superseded or rescinded.
