## CAPABILITIES

The Army Reserve currently provides operational capability and strategic depth to the Total Army and the Joint Force in support of the National Military Strategy and Army commitments worldwide. The Army Reserve comprises nearly 20 percent of the Total Army's organized units and nearly half its total maneuver support.
