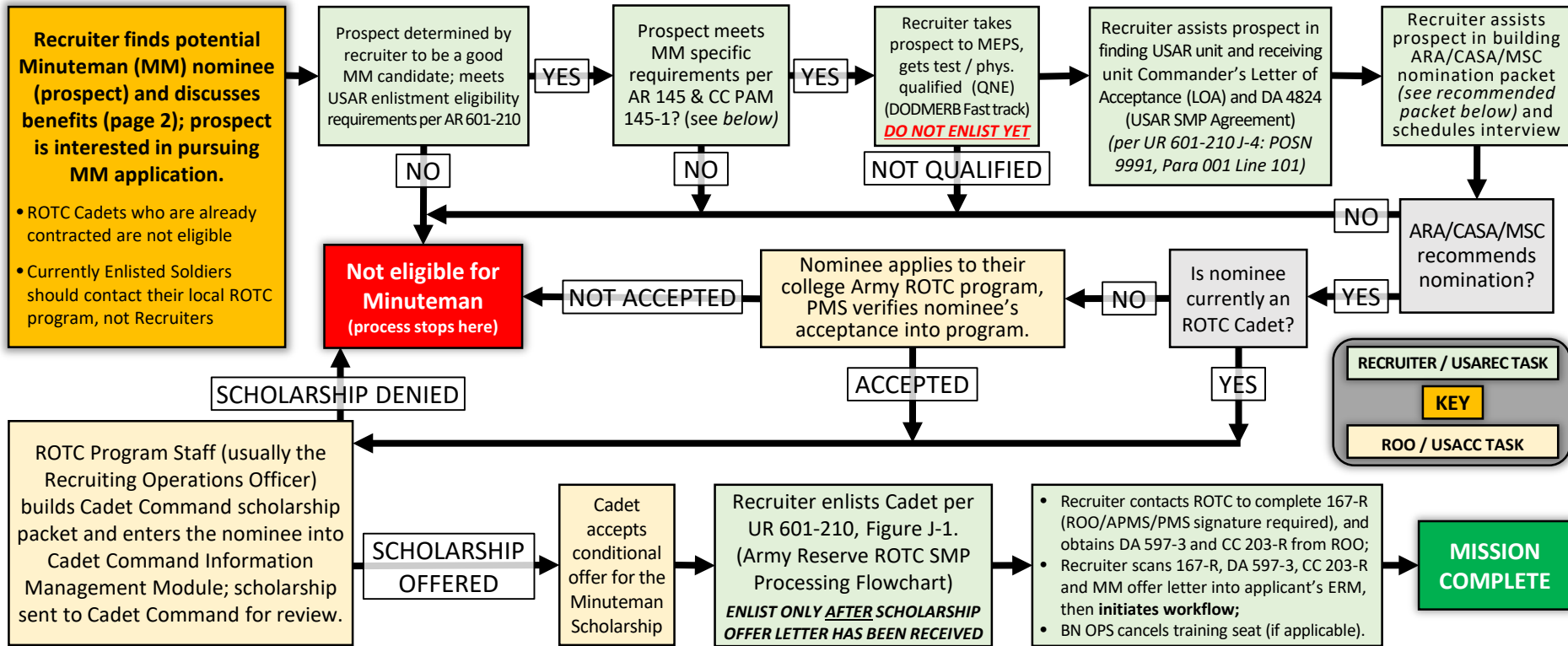


USAR Minuteman Scholarship Flowchart



Minuteman specific requirements (AR-145, chapter 2 and chapter 3):
(Deadlines for MM to be received at USACC: 1 SEP 2018 (Fall 2018) / 1 DEC 2018 (Spring 2019)
(Additional information is contained in CC Pamphlet 145-1. Scholarship eligibility)

- U.S. citizen
- **Between ages of 17-30** - must not reach age 31 by Dec. 31st of commissioning year
- High school graduate before 1 September of the year of award.
- Meet AR 600-9 standards, and "ability to pass" APFT *(note: it is highly recommended that recruiters do not pursue nomination letter until applicant has performed and passed APFT and HT/WT)*
- **Acceptance letter to (or currently enrolled in) college with an Army ROTC program** (contact ROTC prior to initiating packet) and proof of academic major
- **4YR (Non Prior Service):** 24 ACT -or- 1200 SAT // **4YR (Prior Service):** 19 ACT -or- 1000 SAT **3, 2.5 or 2 YR (PS or NPS):** GPA of 2.5 or greater from most recent college semester.

Recommended scholarship evaluation/nomination packet:
(Nominators may add or subtract items at their discretion)

- High school transcript (4-year only)
- Copy of SAT or ACT scores, or proof of most recent college semester GPA (<4YR)
- Full-length photo
- Personal resume or bio, including a list of extracurricular activities
- Short (1-2 page) essay: "Why do you want to become an Army Reserve officer?"

Note: This packet does not replace the requirements for the Scholarship Request Application Packet. Applicants must work with their Army ROTC program to complete the Cadet Command packet.
