ACTIVE GUARD RESERVE

REQUIREMENTS

- · Be at least 18 to 54 years old
- Be in the ranks of SPC-SFC, 2LT-MAJ, or WO1-CW4
- Have less than 15 yrs of Active Federal Service
- · Be eligible for reenlistment or extension
- Be able to meet the medical fitness standards for retention
- Pass a Defense Central Investigative Index
- Have NO referred OER/NCOERs or AERs in the last 36 months

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

- Make sure you meet all of the eligibility requirements
- Apply for The AGR Program on HRC's website
- Wait for the Accessions Team to contact you for a position

THE AGR'S ROLE

The primary role of the AGR force is to provide full-time training, administration, maintenance, readiness, and mobilization/deployment support to the Reserve force. Members of the AGR Program serve in an active-duty status while supporting USAR operations.
