TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- ▶ **4-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP** for incoming college freshmen attending a host ROTC program or a public university at resident rates.
- ▶ **3-YEAR ADVANCE DESIGNEE SCHOLARSHIP (3AD):** 4-year scholarship awarded to an incoming college freshman that pays the last 3 years of benefits provided the applicant successfully meets the requirements to contract after the first year.

BENEFITS

- ▶ Covers full tuition and fees OR room and board (\$10,000 per year) at the participating university of attendance
- ▶ Cadet stipend monthly (\$420 freshman-senior)
- ▶ Book stipend of \$1,200 annually (\$600 per semester)
- ▶ Guaranteed commission in the Army Reserve with an eight-year service obligation

REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Minimum high school GPA: 2.5
- ▶ Minimum test scores: SAT = 1000 or ACT = 19
- ▶ Enlisted or eligible to enlist
- ▶ Must be a U.S. citizen
- ▶ Eligible to participate in the Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP), an experience with an Army Reserve unit while earning additional money for service
- ▶ Meet physical fitness requirements
- ▶ Between the ages of 17-30
