

THE ARMY RESERVE MINUTEMAN SCHOLARSHIP

PROGRAM

Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty (GRFD) Scholarship awarded by United States Army Cadet Command for the Army Reserve



The Minuteman campaign awards 2-4 year scholarships.

- 4-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP may only be awarded to incoming college freshmen attending a host ROTC program or a public university at resident rates.
- 3-YEAR awarded to an incoming college sophomore that pays the last 3 years of benefits provided the applicant successfully meets the requirements to contract.
- 2-YEAR awarded to an incoming college junior or graduate student that pays the last 2 years of benefits provided the applicant successfully meets the requirements to contract.

BENEFITS

- Covers full tuition and fees (in-state) OR room and board (\$10,000 per year) at the participating university of attendance
- ▶ Monthly \$420 Cadet stipend (freshmen-senior year)
- ► Annual \$1,200 book stipend
- Guaranteed commission in the Army Reserve with an eight-year service obligation

REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum high school GPA: 2.5
- Minimum test scores: SAT = 850 or ACT = 19
- ▶ Enlisted or eligible to enlist
- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Eligible to participate in the Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP), an experience with an Army Reserve unit while earning additional money for service
- Meet physical fitness requirements
- ▶ Between age of 17-28
