for the Army Reserve

TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The Minuteman campaign awards 2-4 year scholarships.

- ▶ **4-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP** may only be awarded to incoming college freshmen attending a host ROTC program or a public university at resident rates.
- ▶ **3-YEAR** awarded to an incoming college sophomore that pays the last 3 years of benefits provided the applicant successfully meets the requirements to contract.
- ▶ **2-YEAR** awarded to an incoming college junior or graduate student that pays the last 2 years of benefits provided the applicant successfully meets the requirements to contract.

BENEFITS

- ▶ Covers full tuition and fees (in-state) OR room and board (\$10,000 per year) at the participating university of attendance
- ▶ Monthly \$420 Cadet stipend (freshmen-senior year)
- ▶ Annual \$1,200 book stipend
- ▶ Guaranteed commission in the Army Reserve with an eight-year service obligation

REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Minimum high school GPA: 2.5
- ▶ Minimum test scores: SAT = 850 or ACT = 19
- ▶ Enlisted or eligible to enlist
- ▶ Must be a U.S. citizen
- ▶ Eligible to participate in the Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP), an experience with an Army Reserve unit while earning additional money for service
- ▶ Meet physical fitness requirements
- ▶ Between age of 17-28
