

THE 81st RD YELLOW RIBBON EVENT 2 - 4 MAY 2025 JACKSONVILLE, FL

<u>Task</u>: The Warrior Transition Support Program (WTSP) educated Soldiers and their families about the Soldier Recovery Unit (SRU). Emphasis was placed on the available resources for COMPO 3 Soldiers who need continued care.

Goal: Provide event attendees with information and additional sources for WTSP. Explain the significance of documentation and how it relates to the entry criteria. Educate Soldiers, Leadership, and families on the location of the SRUs and the options available, including RM2 and Resident orders.

Summary: The 81st RD hosted a Pre-Mobilization and Post-Mobilization event for 259 Soldiers and 125 family members. CPT Ferdinand briefed 259 Soldiers and leadership on the SRU process, the Support Coordinators duties, and emphasized on the importance of documented medical issues.

CPT Ferdinand and MSG Smith met with 78 Soldiers and their family members during the Community Partner sessions to provide brochures and inform the attendees about the SRU.
