

THE 88TH RD YELLOW RIBBON EVENT 04-06 APR 2025 INDIANAPOLIS, IN



TASK: The Warrior Transition Support Program (WTSP) educates soldiers and their families about the Soldier Recovery Unit (SRU). Emphasis was placed on the available resources for COMPO 3, who need continued care.

GOAL: Provide event attendees with information and additional sources for WTSP. Explain the significance of documentation and how it relates to the entry criteria. Educate Soldiers, Leadership, and family members on the location of the SRUs and options available, including RM2, Resident, and Non-Resident orders.

Summary:

- The 88th RD hosted a Pre-Mobilization and Post-Mobilization event for 193 Soldiers, 121 family members, and 17 youth, totaling 331 attendees.
- SFC Bobadilla briefed Soldiers and family members on the SRU process. CPT Ferdinand spoke about the required documents to submit SRU packets.
- CPT Ferdinand and SFC Bobadilla set up a WTSP table and met with Soldiers and family members to distribute WTSP pamphlets and handouts, actively engage in direct communication, and share various SRU stories.
- CPT Ferdinand and SFC Bobadilla discussed other issues and concerns other Soldiers wanted to discuss, such as INCAP Pay, 20-year retirement letters, and assistance with the Line of Duty (LOD) process.
