

The 88th RD Yellow Ribbon Event 27-29 June 2025 Minneapolis, MN.



Task: The Warrior Transition Support Program (WTSP) is tasked with educating Soldiers and their families about the Soldier Recovery Unit (SRU). Emphasis was placed on the available resources for COMPO 3 Soldiers who need continued care.

Goal: Provide event attendees with information and additional sources for WTSP. The purpose of this Yellow Ribbon event was to educate pre-mobilizing Soldiers and their families on the Soldier Recovery Unit (SRU) and Remote Medical Management (RM2) programs. Emphasis was placed on accepting SRU-E orders if offered at the MFGI.

Summary:

- The 88th RD hosted a Pre-Mobilization event for 373 Soldiers and 283 family members totaling 656 combined.
- SFC Bobadilla briefed an overview of the WTSP to 16 CDRs and 1SGs from across the 88th RD, as well as Brigadier General Dailey; Deputy Commanding General- Support, 88th RD.
- The WTSP team provided two separate briefings to a total of 373 Soldiers about the SRU and RM2 programs.
- SFC Bobadilla and SFC Hancock met with 112 Soldiers and their family members at the WTSP table to provide more information about our mission and address various questions regarding the WTSP and SRU programs.
- SFC Hancock provided his expertise on medical separations and retirements to numerous higher-ranking NCO's and officers.
