

The 88th RD YELLOW RIBBON EVENT 12-14 SEP 2025 MINNEAPOLIS, MN



Task: The Warrior Transition Support Program (WTSP) is tasked with educating Soldiers and their families about the Soldier Recovery Unit (SRU). Emphasis was placed on the available resources for COMPO 3 Soldiers who need continued care.

Goal: Provide event attendees with information and additional sources for WTSP. The purpose of this Yellow Ribbon event was to educate pre-mobilizing Soldiers and their families on the Soldier Recovery Unit (SRU) and Remote Medical Management (RM2) programs. Emphasis was placed on accepting SRU-E orders if offered at the MFGI.

Summary:

- The 88th RD hosted a Pre-Mobilization and Post-Mobilization event for 122 Soldiers and 108 family members.
- SFC Bobadilla provided two separate briefings to a total of 125 Soldiers about the SRU and RM2 programs.
- SFC Bobadilla and SFC Ferrell met with over 100 Soldier and family members at the WTSP table to provide more information about our mission and address various questions regarding the WTSP and SRU programs.
- SFC Ferrell provided information about the DEMOB process at the Fort Hood MFGI and other key resources Soldiers could utilize after the DEMOB process.
